Categories to be Judged

2016 Show 'n Shine Competition Your Jeep must remain in the Show 'n Shine area until it is judged. Judges decisions are final. Please remember that our judges are knowledgeable volunteers who are donating their time to make this activity possible. Under no circumstance may a participant initiate a discussion with a judge while the participant's Jeep is being evaluated, unless the judge asks a question of the owner. Failure to comply will result in disqualification from the Show 'n Shine competition. Judges can only evaluate what they can see, so be sure to leave your vehicle open as you wish it to be judged, from the opening of the show until after awards. If your vehicle has modifications which are not readily visible, you should document them in a judge's handbook placed in a visible location. This will help ensure that the judges are aware of all modifications. Signs should be incorporated into the theme of the display to inform spectators of the modifications made to a vehicle and to credit individuals who made the entry possible. At **NO TIME** will careless or reckless driving by exhibitors or unnecessary noise from entries be tolerated; this includes during set-up and tear-down hours.

Judges will be examining these aspects of the participating Jeeps:

1. Trail Rig

Best Trail Ready: The Rig most ready to conquer off-road obstacles. Must include all recovery equipment if Equipped with a winch,

- Fire Extinguisher
- Strap
- Shackle
- Tree Saver
- Gloves

2. Hard Luck 4x4

Bring your running and streetable Jeep or 4x4, that has seen one to many hits on the trail or suffered some other damage while being used as Jeeps and 4x4's were meant to be.

3. People's Choice

The BEST all around Jeep determined by your peer voters.

4. Jr. 4x4 Rig

This one is for the future 4x4 (Ages 12 & Under) This is for kids to bring their 4x4 or batt operated rigs to enter the show and shine.

5. Mall Crawler

This award goes to the Jeep or 4x4 that has been cleaned so thoroughly that you would never know if it's been used off road before. (Pavement Princess)

6. Muddiest 4x4

The winner of this award will be the owner of the Jeep or 4x4, that is obviously used off road frequently, perhaps on the way to the show.

7. Classic 4x4

This includes all CJ's, Willys, and other jeeps and trucks built before 1986 regardless of body style. This category is for restored 4x4's as well as modified 4x4's from this time period. Bring out your old iron and put it on display.

8. Jeep Stock Class

No Modification to suspension, driveline, or body.

9. Jeep Semi Modified

Must be street legal

10. Jeep Unlimited

This category includes Jeeps which have 4 or more of the modifications listed below:

6 or more inches of combined lift

Spring over axle kits (leaf spring only) / Coil overs / Air Suspension

37 inch tires or larger / JK models 38 inch tires or larger

6 point or more welded cage

Heavy Body Modifications (flat fenders, high line fenders, comp cuts, etc.)

Axle Swap Gearing of 5.13 or more / Engine Swap or Stroker Cleanest Jeep all years

- 11. 4X4 Stock Class No Modification to suspension, driveline, or body.
- 12. 4X4 Semi Modified Class Must be street legal
- 13, 4X4 Unlimited Class
